This concert will be presented in addition to the full band Spring Concert, so that all of our bands – concert, symphonic, and jazz – can showcase more literature without the duration of the concerts becoming excessive.

\*May 4 – Percussion Studio Recital:

This will be presented as a “percussion only” performance. It will feature small percussion ensembles and solo works. This will be separate from the full Spring Concert, so that our percussionists have the opportunity to showcase more pieces of literature than they would be able to otherwise. It will be presented in the LHS chorus room, where the audience will observe the performance from the chorus risers.
